

Inland Community Eye Health Care Program Free The Oppressed Report 2021 March

The community eye health care program Free The Oppressed in Karen state—the eye mission in Karen state continues forward but compared to prior years some of The eye mission has stop in certain area. The continued pandemic of corona virus has restricted the border between Thailand and Myanmar; and continues to close the Bridge and the border land. We cannot easily cross the border but still, our team we can cross the border in eastern Karen state by using a natural road. Our team can only organize the eye care program in the jungle village and we gave health promotion and health prevention to the villager and community leaders how to be safe from corona virus. Our mission is now focusing only on K6 but we can see that some of our patients came from K4 and k1 with a seven and eight hours drive to the clinic. We asked them that why did you come here? They said "they cannot go to government hospital because they have to spend so much money to get their treatment . So our eye patient keeps coming since we have opened eye clinic. So far, our eye missions only at (K6 Doo Playa District – Noe Tar Kaw Township) in Jungle villages.
