Subject – Internal Displacement Person report

Introduction – First of all, our eye program objective is to provide aid for whose have a visual impairment beside that we also provide other humanitarian aid as needed. So, in the following paragraph I would like to inform you about how our program provides a humanitarian aid for the Internal Displacement Person (IDP) along Thai-Myanmar border.

On March 28 to April 8, 2022, our eye program had a mission at Lay Tar Au Tar clinic but due to the fighting happened earlier between combined military group and KNLA on our way to the clinic, so we had to cancel our planned. On the same day, totally there were 500 persons fled to Lay Taw Koh and Tee Poe Ra Kee to the Thai side in addition among them did not have main food and other supplies. On the next day, we visited them at Lay Taw Koh and met with the Thai local leader. During the discussion with Thai local leader they guaranteed for IDP safety and requested us to be responsible for food and shelter. By the grace of God, on March 29, 2022 we received the supply for the first round such as rice and tent from our friends. There are so many way of donation, some are support us in financial but other by the foods and other supplies.

In the bottom of our heart, we give thanks to our friends and churches from the abroad because you love us and love your people and support them when they are in needed. The money that you donate shows in the below.

On March 28, 2022 we visited IDP at Lay Tong Ku Heath Center. There were 9 families approximately 50 persons. Most of them were women and children. As much as we can for the first thing, we gave them oil and dry noodles for every family also a shelter for them to rescue.















Later a few hours, there were more villagers arrived at Lay Tong Ku Health Center. They came from a different places; some came by foot and some by machine. As we can see in the picture below, there were so many approximately 170 persons in total.















We met with Thai local leaders and discussed about the plan for the villagers.

Her name is Naw Eh Mu La, 21 years old. She come from Jay Pa Let. She gave birth to Naw Kli Thoo, two-day old baby girl in the forest. Luckily, in their group they have one mid-wife help her for labor. She is healthy and her mom is in the stage for recovery.

In speaking, food is the main source for human to live but medication is also important as well to keep us health. Along with the visit, we distributed medication to them. In every one day or two, our medic will walk around every IDP camp to take care of them and refer them to hospital if needed.

All the money that you sent to us not use only for foods and other supplies but we also use some money to buy for medication. All these medications will be used directly for IDP and who are in needed.

*For today (09/04/22) updated IDP population there are **2300** persons in seven different places. Some of they stay in their relative home but some are stay on their own in the IDP camp.

The picture shows all above are the activity that we had done from the last few days. We do the camp visiting, provide treatment, give the supply, communicate with local leader to get everything go smoothly. Sometime we can not get every photo to show you all because we also need to consider for their safety so we hope you could understand us.
