



Cross Border Community Eye Care Program Free the Oppressed Report – August to September 24, 2023

The eye program has increased its assistance for the people in Kawthoolei, along with other ethnicities who live in Burma, requiring eye treatment. Therefore, Community eye care program, Free the Oppressed aims to plan, procure, transport, and deliver the public health components related to the eyes and vision: vision screening, dispensing of spectacles, collaborate to bring cataract and other eye surgery to people in Karen state. we organized and eye mission, we received a lot of patients coming from different regions to receive the treatment, even though the transportation was difficult. Currently, another factor that stop them to not coming for eye treatment is because of the civil war in Burma. Most Karen people and other people living in remote area are poor. They cannot go to city hospital for treating their eye, because of they not enough money to pay. We will be heading out to help out with this project. We are sure to see many elders who are dealing with this difficulty in their eyes.

Everything went well throughout the mission even though the plane flew over us every single day, the fighting is still happening among the arm groups besides due to raining season and the road got destroyed but still we received a lot of patients all over the area.

In this mission we screened 154 patients and the detail information is showed below.

First of all, we estimated around 70 patients will come for eye screening but for this mission we totally screened 177 patients.
