

<u>Cross Border Community Eye Care Program Free the Oppressed Report – 22 to 29</u> October, 2023

The eye program has increased its assistance for the people in Kawthoolei, along with other ethnicities who live in Burma, requiring eye treatment. Therefore, Community eye care program, Free the Oppressed aims to plan, procure, transport, and deliver the public health components related to the eyes and vision: vision screening, dispensing of spectacles, collaborate to bring cataract and other eye surgery to people in Karen state.

The revolutionary war on the Karen people has been going on for seven decades of experience without gaining access to self-determination and the recognition of the nation. To achieve the goal of independence, the Karen people require unity. This reason, United Committee for Karen Armed Group (UCKAG) was formed.

UCKAG is a Karen Armed Group aim to work together on Karen national affairs under on political objective. The UCKAG was formed on May 28, 2023 and its members are the KNU, the Democratic Karen Buddhist Army (DKBA), the KNU/KNLA Peace Councial, and the Border GuardForce(BGF).

In October 22 to 29, 23, Community eye care program, Free the Oppressed was invited by UCKAG to organize eye mission at Hpa An. We saw this as an opportunity to bring unity among us and could benefit to the patient, so we agreed to work together.

This is going to be the second mission at Hpa An district, Doe Yi sub-district, at Tee Yaw temples. UCKAG are responsible for security and from 22 of October we started the eye mission.
