As presented in the March meeting, in April, we embarked on a mission to the Toe Tet Kee K1 clinic. During our first mission in January 2024, the demand exceeded the supply we had brought. Therefore, for this mission, we aimed to respond to the patients' needs. We commenced our trip on April 21st and 22nd, starting treatments on the 23rd and concluding on May 2nd. During the first two days, we received a lot of patients, but on the third day, the presence of SAC Jack fighters flying around our area alarmed the patients, causing many of them to return home. Nevertheless, we still had many patients to attend to. In the future, we plan to visit Toe Tet Kee clinic once a year because the patients need our assistance.
